


Some of his notable contributions has been helping children and adults understand and integrate with the physical world, integrating therapeutic process for mental and physical health such as patients with Parkinson's, utilising specific and defined techniques to learn art forms, transcending borders bringing people & communities together. He greatly encourages playfulness, creativity, while placing emphasis on community health. James, will make a short presentation which will be followed by a Q&A session and open discussion.
