Activities of the Macedonian Centre of ITI

Activities

- Macedonian Centre of ITI was reformed in the frame of Upniversity Euro Balkan, Skopje, Macedonia. There are three members in the Executive Board in 2013, 15 members in the Program Board, and 6 members in the Dance Board, one member of Theatre Education and Training Committee (TECOM) and 21 honorary members from the former Macedonian Centre of ITI.
- Collecting data from 11 International performing arts festivals in Macedonia for the International Festival Forum (IFF) 2013/2015.
- Started collaboration with OISTAT International on the projects Digital Theater Words International / Digital Theater Words Macedonia 2013/2015.
- Registration of 29 individual members and collaborators and 32 institutional members and collaborators of Macedonian Centre of ITI, 2013/2015.
- Active Facebook Page and open group on Facebook, for sharing international and local calls for performing arts professionals and theatre lovers (festivals, workshops, exhibitions, competitions, auditions etc.) The website is functioning as a sub link under the domain of University Euro Balkan. We developed an active collaboration with local media.
