#### XXIV Theatre Lovers National Meeting.

Held from 7 to 29 January at the INBA Julio Jiménez Rueda Theatre, from Friday to Sunday, 42 theatre companies presented their work, showing from 3 to 4 performances each day. More than 14000 spectators have attended the meeting. The stage companies came from the states of Oaxaca, Aguascalientes, Nuevo León, Guanajuato, Campeche, Yucatán, Morelos, Jalisco, Estado de México and the Distrito Fedz



- Participation in the **Cultural Identity and Development Committee CIDC Meeting** in Manila, Philippines. The Mexican Centre of ITI was represented during the worldwide launch of the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the World Theatre Day in the Philippines, in conjunction with the meeting of the Cultural Identity and Development Board in a dialogue around the theme "Creativity / Cosecha de Buenas Prácticas de teatro para la paz y el desarrollo sostenible" from 4 to 9 March. Isabel Quintanar of the Mexican Centre of ITI is also the Vice-President of CIDC. The eminent figures attending in this delegation were:
