## Yi People Of China

The Yi people are the sixth-largest ethnic minority in China, with a population of around 9.8 million and a history of over 3,000 years.

The Yi people have a vibrant culture that has flourished over thousands of years. It is shaped by the wisdom of their ancestors and their relationship with the natural world, exemplified by such forces as the tiger and the eagle. Their intricate and profound cosmology weaves together their beliefs, values, and practices, enabling the Yi people to navigate their journey from ancient times to the present day.

In *Star Returning*, the Bimo and the young people of Yi speak to the world, communicating their sense of existence, struggle and beauty, and life as a triumph over death.

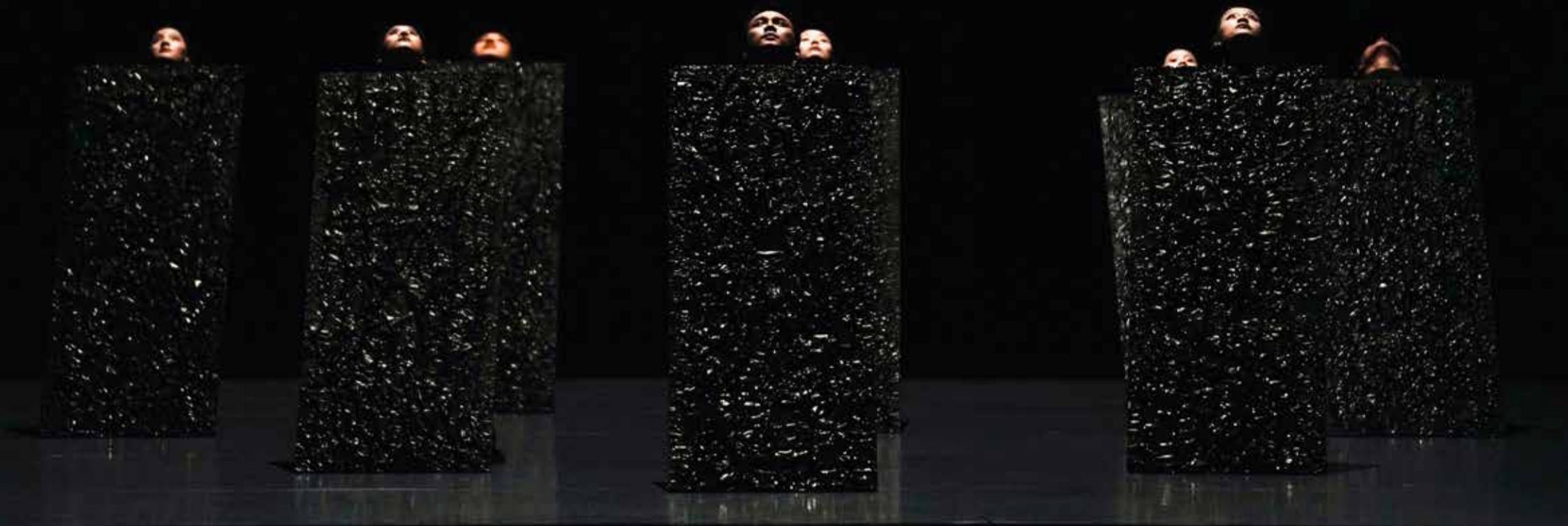
### **21. Lullaby**

Wucaiyunxia New Culture & Art is affiliated with Liangshan Culture and Tourism Group, which is a state-owned cultural enterprise based in Sichuan Province, China. The organization is an important cultural institution in Sichuan Province and a national cultural industry demonstration base. They have made significant contributions to promoting the ethnic culture of the Greater Liangshan region and to the cultural development of Liangshan Prefecture. The organization has received numerous awards for its work in film and television production and has showcased outstanding performances on both domestic and international stages.

### **Lemi Ponifasio / MAU**

With a unique artistic lineage, Ponifasio's creations defy conventional definitions. He guides the modern individual towards new cosmologies and altered states of consciousness through the decelerated rhythm of his aesthetic—a palette of black, dreamlike imagery; the ceremonial, sacrificial body; a visceral interplay of sound, light, and darkness.

While established in the international avant-garde, Ponifasio's work deeply engages with local communities and diverse indigenous cultures. He draws on complex forms of knowledge—oratory, navigation, dance, music, and philosophies—to emphasize local arts and indigenous cultural recovery.

His collaborators are from all walks of life, staging works in diverse venues—factories, villages, opera houses, galleries, and more. Ponifasio's projects range from operas to community forums, presented globally at prominent festivals and venues, including Avignon Festival, BAM New York, Edinburgh International Festival, and the Venice Biennale.

Founding MAU in 1995, Ponifasio creates a philosophical foundation for his work. The Samoan term MAU signifies the declaration of truth as a path to transformation, focusing on arts, avant-garde thinking, and culture. It aims to challenge theatrical authority and redefine our understanding of humanity while fostering new arts, workshops, and community initiatives to cultivate knowledge and address our ecological crisis.

Lemi Ponifasio is a High Chief of Samoa. He holds the titles Tuala and Sala. He is ITI-UNESCO World Theatre Ambassador.
